

Section 229 of the Welfare and Institutions Code states, in part, "It shall be the duty of a juvenile justice commission to inquire into the administration of the juvenile court law..." In order for the Orange County Juvenile Justice Commission to fulfill its mandated function, it is deemed necessary that the Juvenile Justice Commission have access to relevant records regarding youth who are involved in the juvenile justice system. Juvenile Justice Commissioners and their Administrative Officer should be allowed to inspect such records and to receive copies, have access to minors housed in local institutions, and attend certain regularly scheduled or ad hoc meetings relating to juvenile justice administration for

1 review whenever a minor is under the jurisdiction of the Juvenile
2 Court and is the subject of such review.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all members of the Juvenile
4 Justice Commission, and the Commission's Administrative Officer,
5 shall sign an Oath of Confidentiality affirming that information
6 obtained as a result of the activities of the Juvenile Justice
7 Commission shall not be shared with any agency or person without the
8 express written authorization of the Presiding Judge of the Juvenile
9 Court.
