MANDATED BY FEDERAL LAW.**


TO: CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER, COUNTY OF ORANGE

United States Code Title 13 - Census, authorizes that certain information is to be collected by representatives of the Census Bureau. This process includes interviewing a sampling of minors in juvenile detention facilities and gathering demographic information, including names, during an interview process. This activity is mandated by Federal law. The United States government ensures strict confidentiality of individualized Census information under various laws. Title 13 requires the collection of Census information on a regularly scheduled basis. The Orange County Probation Department is seeking authorization to facilitate the Census interview process with representatives of the Census Bureau.
