22 **TO: EXECUTIVE OFFICER/CLERK OF THE SUPERIOR COURT**

24 The District Attorney's Office is authorized to inspect and obtain copies of Juvenile Court  
25 Records without a court order pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code Section 827 and  
26 California Rule of Court 5.552. However, the District Attorney is not authorized to further  
27 disseminate these records without an order of the Juvenile Court. The judicial officer

1 presiding in a case is in the best position to determine if the information in the Juvenile  
2 Court file is sufficiently relevant to the pending case to merit further dissemination.

4 **FOR GOOD CAUSE SHOWN THEREFOR, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Superior  
5 Court Judicial Officers hearing cases involving a prosecution for violation of the Street  
6 Terrorism Enforcement and Prevention Act, Section 186.22 of the Penal Code, or the  
7 Three Strikes Law, Section 667 of the Penal Code, are appointed to act as a Temporary  
8 Juvenile Court Judge for purposes of determining relevancy and admissibility of Juvenile  
9 Court records under Welfare and Institutions Code Section 827, and California Rule of  
10 Court 5.552.
