

(New Proposed Rule)

Local Rule 314A - Register of Actions References For Related Documents

Any electronically filed document that is filed in response to another filed document shall include on the first page a reference to the Register of Actions number of the related document. This Rule does not apply to documents filed for trial.

For proceedings in civil law and motion, as defined in California Rules of Court, rule 3.1103, the first page of the document shall reference the Register of Actions number of the related Notice of Motion on all electronically filed Motion, Opposition, Reply, and supporting papers.

The Register of Actions number reference must be made below the nature of the paper statement (required by California Rules of Court, rule 2.111(6)), and above the hearing date, hearing time, and department (required by Rule 314). The documents must have clearly typed: "RELATED TO ROA # (insert number(s))."
