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GUIDELINES FOR FILING CIVIL SISTER-STATE JUDGMENTS

Please refer to sections 1710.15 - 1710.45 of the California Code of Civil Procedure for specific information on filing an Application for Sister-State Judgment.

Submit the following:

- Filing Fee for Civil First Paper.** California Government Code Section 26820.4. See Fee Schedule for current fees for filing a first paper in a limited or unlimited civil action.

- Civil Case Cover Sheet**.....California Judicial Council Form 982.2(b)(1)
(This is the only cover sheet required by Orange County Superior Court.)

- Application for Entry of Judgment on Sister-State Judgment**.....California Judicial Council Form EJ-105
(An Application from an out-of-state attorney would be accepted)

- An **authenticated, exemplified or certified copy** of the original judgment.

- Notice of Entry of Judgment on Sister-State Judgment**.....California Judicial Council Form EJ-110

- Self-addressed, stamped envelope for returning any copies.

- Mail the above information to the appropriate Justice Center:
 - ▶ Civil judgments of \$25,000 or less (limited civil actions)
See Venue Table - Form L-1170
 - ▶ Civil judgments exceeding \$25,000 (unlimited civil actions)
