EFFECTIVE DATE OF PROPOSED LOCAL RULES

JULY 1, 2014

As the Courts are required to periodically review their Local Rules to ensure they are current and in compliance with existing statutes, state rules, and local practices, the Orange County Superior Court proposed revisions to the Local Rules of Court in compliance with the Government Code section 68071 and the California Rules of Court, rule 10.613. The proposed revisions will become effective July 1, 2014, if approved by the Judicial Council.

The rules impacted by the proposed changes if approved by the Judicial Council are listed below.

Rule 700	Subject Matter of the Family Law Court (revised)

Rule 704	Ex Parte Matters (revised)
Rule 900.5	Unique Person Identifier (revised)
