Juvenile Court Administrative Order No. 11/002

After Hour and Holiday Emergency Medical Consent Requests, Probable Cause Declarations, and Dependency Warrants

This rule governs the procedure to be followed for emergency non-business hour requests.

- A. Medical Consents: If immediate authorization is required on evenings, weekends or holidays, the Supervising Social Worker will contact the judicial officer by telephone after review of the request and verbally convey the information contained in the form. The Duty Judge may make arrangements to also receive the information by Fax, email or hand delivery. If the original was not provided to the Judicial Officer, the Social Worker will deliver the original to Juvenile Court Administration by 10:00 am the next business day. The Judicial Officer and his/her clerk will process any follow up information required and a minute order for the file.
- **B. Probable Cause Declarations:** For weekends and holidays, the Duty Judge is to provide a contact phone number to Custody Intake by 10:00 a.m. The Duty Judge will be read the declaration over the phone and can make arrangements to also receive the information by Fax, email or hand delivery. The Original shall be provided to Juvenile Administrative staff by 10:00 a.m. the next business day.
- C. Dependency Warrants: If immediate authorization is required on evenings, weekends or holidays, County Counsel will contact the duty judicial officer by telephone after review of the request and verbally convey the information contained in the form. The Duty Judge may make arrangements to also receive the information by Fax, email or hand delivery. County Counsel will deliver the original to Juvenile Court Administration by 10:00 am the next business day.

D. Delinquency Warrants: Search Warrants and Arrest Warrants for Delinquency matters required after hours, on weekends or holidays will be issued by the Orange County Superior Court duty magistrate.

This Juvenile Court Administrative Order is to remain in effect until otherwise ordered by the Presiding Judge of Juvenile Court.
