Expanding Online Access to Criminal & Traffic Case Information for Defense Attorneys Criminal Defense Attorney Portal (CDAP)

Orange County Superior Court now offers an expanded Web-based solution providing attorneys representing defendants in criminal and traffic cases with online access to case information on any case in the Vision system. Previously, defense attorneys were only able to access cases online in which they were the attorney of record. Defense attorneys can quickly access information about a case through the Court's Web site. By simply clicking on the case link, attorneys can view all aspects of a case including defendant demographics, filings, hearing information, minutes, and, if convicted, sentencing information. Additionally, defense attorneys can now access the court's daily calendar.

Training for attorneys interested in using the system is also available to learn what information can be accessed and how to access it through the online Criminal Defense Attorney Portal.
