Succeeded to court upon majority vote of judges in county [pursuant to Prop. 220] to convert Municipal Courts to Superior Courts, effective August 10, 1998. Elected to West Orange County Municipal Court (succeeding Judge Kenneth M. Smith, retired) June 6, 1988, for term commencing January 2, 1989 (oath January 3, 1989), and reelected in subsequent election.
