He also reported, the Youth Counsel is actively involved in planning events for the youth in their unit. No corrective action notices given.

North Youth Resource Center (YRC) Visit

Commissioners Vachet and Winder visited North YRC for an inspection on August 25, 2023. Commissioner Winder reported they currently have 11 youth and are maintaining a 90-100% school attendance rate. The youth also attend daily therapy. No corrective action notices given.

Childhelp – Baker & Joann

Commissioners Churchill, Perring, and Winder visited the Short-Term Residential Therapeutic Programs (STRTP) Baker and Joann for an inspection on August 30, 2023. Commissioner Perring provided a summary of the visit. She reported their goal is to provide trauma informed care. When interviewed the youth provided positive feedback. No corrective action notices given.
