

**Notice of Intent to Escheat Unclaimed Funds on Deposit or Held  
by the Court under Government Code §68084.1**

You are hereby advised that the Superior Court has been holding funds for uncashed Juror checks in the amount of \$174,741.32 that have not been claimed for at least three years since the payment was issued and the funds first became eligible for disbursement. These uncashed checks are for Jury services performed December 2008 through September 2017. Under Gov. Code § 68084.1(a), the funds will become the property of the Superior Court if the owner(s) fail to present a claim or file a verified complaint seeking recovery of the funds by 12/11/2020, a date not less than 45 days nor more than 60 days after first publication of this notice. The individual amounts and details of the unclaimed property are available through the link listed below.

If you believe that you, or a person for whom you are a legal guardian or representative, are entitled to all or a portion of the funds held by the Superior Court, you must submit the claim form available through the link listed below or file and serve a verified complaint no later than 12/11/2020. The claim form must be submitted before the date designated herein.
