TEMPORARY SCHEDULE FOR DETAINED AND NON-DETAINED

DETENTION HEARINGS IN DEPENDENCY CASES

IT IS ORDERED: In response to the April 22, 2021, Order of Chief Justice Tani Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the California Judicial Council (hereinafter "April 22, 2021, Gov. Code § 68115 Order") and the Orange County Superior Court's "Amended Implementation Order Re: Emergency Relief Authorized by Governor Executive Order and by the Judicial Council of California" issued on April 23, 2021, (hereinafter "Implementation Order"), the Juvenile Court is instituting the following scheduling procedures for detention hearings in dependency cases:

- 1. Pursuant to the April 22, 2021, Gov. Code § 68115 Order, the Implementation Order and Government Code section 68115, subdivision (a)(11), detention hearings conducted pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 315, regarding the removal of a child from the custody of a parent(s) or other custodial caregivers, will be heard as follows:
 - a. Petitions filed on Monday will be set for detention hearing the following Wednesday;
 - b. Petitions filed on Tuesday will be set for detention hearing the following Thursday;
 - c. Petitions filed on Wednesday will be set for detention hearing the following Friday;
 - d. Petitions filed on Thursday will be set for detention hearing the following Monday; and
 - e. Petitions filed on Friday will be set for detention hearing the following Tuesday.
- 2. The scheduling of petitions identified under numbered paragraph 1 of this Order modifies the scheduling previously set forth in the Revised Administrative Order: A-200-5-2020. The scheduling set forth in this order will remain in effect unless and until modified or rescinded by a later Administrative Order.

3. Non-detained detention hearings in dependency cases will be calendared the 7th calendar day after the date the petition was filed. If the 7th calendar day falls on a weekend or holiday, the hearing will be calendared on the next court day after the 7th calendar day.
