Who can participate?	Any Self-Represented Litigant who needs help clearing Probate Notes for Guardianship, Conservatorship and Decedent's Estate cases.
Why join?	The Court cannot allow your case to move forward until all Probate Notes are cleared. You must clear all notes and file required documents at least <u>5 court days</u> (not including weekends or Court Holidays) before your next hearing.
What is involved?	This workshop includes a presentation on how to clear the most common Probate Notes, opportunity for participants to ask questions about their own notes, and instructions on how to access other important Self-Help services.
When?	Every Monday at 9:00 a.m. except for Court Holidays.
Where?	You will not come to the Court. Participants attend by logging onto Microsoft Teams on their own computer, smartphone or tablet. An invitation and detailed instructions will be provided upon registration.
