The court began processing Appellate related matters as of May 26, 2020.

The **Criminal Appeals Unit** accepts and processes Felony notices of appeal that are heard by the Court of Appeal, as well as infraction and misdemeanor appeals heard by the Appellate Division.

1. Processing of appeal matters resumed as of May 26, 2020.
2. All filings received by the Court during the designated holiday period of March 17, 2020 through May 22, 2020 will be deemed filed as of May 26, 2020.
3. Felony case filings for the Criminal Appeals Unit can be submitted to the court as follows:
 - By drop-box located by the front entrance of the Central Justice Center. Party is to provide a phone number for court contact;
 - Felony Appeals can be sent via US Mail to 700 Civic Center Drive West, Santa Ana, CA 92701 – **Attn: Criminal Appeals**
4. Misdemeanor and Infraction case filings for the Criminal Appellate Division can be submitted to the court as follows:
 - By drop-box located at the front entrance of the case's assigned justice center. Party is to provide a phone number for court contact.
