20 Exercising the authority granted by Governor Gavin Newsom’s Executive Order
21 N-38-20 and the June 18, 2020 Order of Chief Justice Tani Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the
22 California Judicial Council, issued in response to the June 17, 2020 Request for a Judicial
23 Emergency Order made by the Superior Court of Orange County (“Court”), this Court
24
25 **HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL MEASURES:**

26 1. The Court extends the time period provided in section 313 of the Welfare and
27 Institutions Code within which a minor taken into custody pending dependency proceedings
28 must be released from custody to not more than 3 days. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(11).) This
applies only to minors for whom the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from
6/22/2020 to 7/17/2020, inclusive.


2. The Court extends the time period provided in section 315 of the Welfare and
Institutions Code within which a minor taken into custody pending dependency proceedings

1 must be given a detention hearing to not more than 3 days. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(11).)
2 This applies only to minors for whom the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from
3 6/22/2020 to 7/17/2020, inclusive.

4 It is the intent of this Order to provide the maximum length of constitutionally
5 permitted continuance days authorized by the June 18, 2020 Order of Chief Justice Tani
6 Cantil-Sakauye issued in response to the June 17, 2020 Request for a Judicial Emergency
7 Order made by the Court. Any conflicts in the above language are to be resolved in favor of
8 granting the lengthier of the continuance options.
