19 Exercising the authority granted by Governor Gavin Newsom’s Executive Order  
20 N-38-20 and the July 16, 2020 Order of Chief Justice Tani Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the  
21 California Judicial Council, issued in response to the July 15, 2020 Request for a Judicial  
22 Emergency Order made by the Superior Court of Orange County (“Court”), this Court  
23 **HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL MEASURES:**

24 1. The Court extends the time period provided in section 313 of the Welfare and  
25 Institutions Code within which a minor taken into custody pending dependency proceedings  
26 must be released from custody to not more than 3 days. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(11).) This  
27 applies only to minors for whom the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from  
28 7/20/2020 to 8/14/2020, inclusive.


2. The Court extends the time period provided in section 315 of the Welfare and  
Institutions Code within which a minor taken into custody pending dependency proceedings

1 must be given a detention hearing to not more than 3 days. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(11).) This  
2 applies only to minors for whom the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from  
3 7/20/2020 to 8/14/2020, inclusive.

4 It is the intent of this Order to provide the maximum length of constitutionally  
5 permitted continuance days authorized by the July 16, 2020 Order of Chief Justice Tani Cantil-  
6 Sakauye issued in response to the July 15, 2020 Request for a Judicial Emergency Order made  
7 by the Court.
