UPDATE – Monday, June 8, 2020

Due to the COVID-19 social distancing requirements, the public will have limited access to court buildings.

The Records Unit is located at the Central Justice Center and provides various services including access to case index searches, viewing electronic records and processing copy requests.

As of May 26, 2020, and until further notice, in-person access to the Records Unit will be limited in order to comply with social distancing. The public is encouraged to take advantage of online services to avoid traveling to court buildings.

1. Requests for records and certified copies can be submitted to the court as noted below.
 - Online by sending an email to: cjcrecordsmanagement@occourts.org. Please provide as much information as possible with your requests such as case number, case name, and file date of document(s), if known. A Records representative will contact you regarding payment.
 - Via telephone by calling (657) 622-7806 or (657) 622-7809.
 - In-person by scheduling an appointment through the court's website <https://www.occourts.org/media-relations/CourtCalendarAppointments.html>. Appointments can be scheduled up to one week in advance.
2. In-person record searches require the scheduling of an appointment through the court's website. One-hour sessions will be allowed and can be extended if the next member of the public is not waiting for the use of a computer terminal.
