Who can participate?	Any Self-Represented Litigant who needs help starting a Divorce, Separation, or Nullity case. If you already have an open case for Divorce, Separation, or Nullity, you should not attend this workshop.
What is required?	You will need internet access and an email address where you can complete, send, and receive documents. This workshop is conducted in English.
What is involved?	The presentation is about 60 minutes, followed by a question-and-answer session. At the end of the presentation, attendees will receive instructions on how to file and how to receive 1-on-1 services from Self-Help staff.
