

General Family Law eFiling Exceptions List

Effective January 1st, 2018, pursuant to local rule [700.7](#), the Orange County Superior Court will mandate attorneys to utilize electronic filing (eFiling) in the Family Law Division, except for the following:

CASE PROCESSING

1. Appellate Documents
2. Bonds
3. Non-Summary Dissolution Judgment Forms
(e.g., FL-180 and FL-250), and Judgment
Packets
4. Writs/Abstracts

CASE TYPE SPECIFIC

1. Name/Gender Change Request
2. Out-of-State Registration Filings
3. Surrogacy Filings

COURTROOM

1. Findings and Order After Hearing, Order After
Hearing and Judgments
2. Hearing Documents Over 25MB in Size that
Cannot Be Compressed
3. Subpoenaed Documents
4. Trial Exhibits
