Donald Noble Selected as Grand Jury Foreperson

Santa Ana, Calif. – Donald Noble of Huntington Beach, was selected as the foreperson for the 2019-2020 Orange County Grand Jury, Orange County Superior Court Presiding Judge Kirk Nakamura announced earlier this month.

"Mr. Noble's career as Finance Director in large firms, leading employees from diverse backgrounds toward a common end goal, makes him clearly qualified to be foreperson of the 19-member Grand Jury," said Judge Nakamura.

Mr. Donald Noble was born in Detroit. He came to Southern California as a child and lived here his whole life. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Accounting from California State University at Los Angeles in 1972.

Mr. Noble held positions in finance and accounting throughout his long career. In 1982, he started working for the Downey Regional Medical Center and in his 20-year service for that institution he reached the position of Finance Director. Following his work for the Downey Regional Medical Center, he worked as the Corporate Controller for Children's Hospital of Orange County, managing a staff of over 20 people and directing the financial work for five corporate entities.

The 19 members of the Grand Jury took the official oath of office and were charged with their duties for the one-year term of service on Friday, June 28, 2019, 10:00 a.m., in Department C1 of the Central Justice Center, 700 Civic Center Drive West, Santa Ana. Last month, members of the current Grand Jury and their advisors conducted a four-day training and orientation program for the Grand Jury members and the alternates.
