Orange County Superior Court Launches 2026 All Rise Student Mentor Program

Santa Ana, CA — The Orange County Superior Court is proud to announce the return of its **All Rise Student Mentor Program**, a dynamic and immersive summer experience designed to introduce high school students to the legal system and careers in the justice field.

The five-day program offers incoming 11th and 12th grade students a unique opportunity to gain valuable insight into court operations, interact with judicial officers and court personnel, and explore potential career paths in the legal profession.

Two sessions will be offered in 2026:

- **June 22 – June 26, 2026**
- **July 6 – July 10, 2026**
- **8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.**
- Limited to **50 students per week**

Throughout the week, participants will:

- Interact with courtroom staff
- Visit with the District Attorney and Public Defender's offices
- Gain insights from Orange County Sheriff's personnel
- Observe live court proceedings
- Participate in interactive demonstrations and legal professional panel presentations
- Tour the Court of Appeal (Fourth District, Division Three), Federal Court, and Superior Court, followed by Q&A sessions
- Receive a Certificate of Completion

The application period runs **March 23 through May 1, 2026**. *Incomplete or late applications will be placed on a waiting list.*

The program will be held at the Orange County Superior Court, 700 Civic Center Drive West, Santa Ana, CA 92701.
