### JUVENILE JUSTICE – TRUANCY COURT CASE REASSIGNMENT

#### JUDGE ALLISON W. CHAN – L44 – EFFECTIVE WEDNESDAY, APRIL 22, 2026

Judge Allison W. Chan will be assigned to the Juvenile Justice – Truancy Court (Department L44) at the Lamoreaux Justice Center, effective April 22, 2026.

This is your notice that all Juvenile Justice – Truancy Court cases currently assigned to Judge Joe T. Perez (Department L42) for all purposes, and all Juvenile Justice – Truancy Court cases assigned to Judge Joe T. Perez (Department L42) for all purposes between now and April 21, 2026, will be reassigned to Judge Allison W. Chan (Department L44), for all purposes, on the effective date, April 22, 2026.

If you are an attorney who is appointed or retained to represent a party in a new Juvenile Justice – Truancy Court case assigned to Judge Joe T. Perez for all purposes between now and April 21, 2026, based on this advance notice, notice of your case's reassignment to Judge Allison W. Chan will be deemed effective on the date of your appointment or, if you are retained, notice will be deemed effective the first time you appear on behalf of your client on the case, or the first time your client appears in the case, whichever comes first.

Any peremptory challenge filed against Judge Allison W. Chan prior to the effective date of April 22, 2026 shall be directed to Judge Craig E. Arthur, Presiding Judge of Juvenile Court. Any peremptory challenge filed after the effective date of April 22, 2026 shall be directed to Judge Allison W. Chan or Judge Craig E. Arthur, Presiding Judge of Juvenile Court.

*Unless otherwise indicated, once a case is assigned to a particular judge or commissioner, the assignment is for all purposes. (Superior Court of California, County of Orange Local Rule 900.2; Orange County Juvenile Court Administrative Order No. 11/003-900)*

*Pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 170.6(a)(2), peremptory challenges are timely only if they are filed within 15 days after notice of the reassignment, or if the party has not yet appeared in the action, then 15 days after the first appearance.*
