How to Open the Zoom Application:

How to Download:

1. In your web browser, follow/copy and paste the following link:

2. Under **Zoom Client for Meetings**, select **Download**.



Contact CTS if you do not have the proper permission to download Zoom Client for Meetings. However, most Zoom hearings can be accessed through your browser/email. See instructions below for how to join hearing through your email or browser.



How to Join a Hearing from your Device:

Joining through e-mail:

1. When joining via an e-mail sent to you, click on the link listed below "**Join Zoom Meeting.**"




2. The link will automatically open the **Zoom** application installed on your Desktop or open the Zoom application through your browser.

Joining through Meeting ID:

1. Open the **Zoom** application on your Desktop
2. Select **Join a Meeting**




3. Enter the 11-digit **Meeting ID** number given to you by the host of the meeting. The screen name may also be modified; you may also toggle video/audio settings. Once configured, select **Join**.



Zoom Interface


1. When entering the Zoom meeting through your device, a notification will pop up asking your preferred audio channel. Select **Join with Computer Audio**.




2. At the bottom of the screen, a wide array of buttons appears when the cursor is used to hover over the screen. The ability to **Mute** and **Stop Video** appear on the far left.




3. The Host of the meeting may select the **Security** button to *Lock Meetings* or *Enable Waiting Rooms*. You may also allow/disable the participants' ability to *Unmute/Mute* themselves, *Chat*, or *Share Screen*.




4. To see a list of participants within the hearing, select **Participants**.



5. To start a chat with a participant in this meeting, click **Chat**




To send a message to a specific participant, select their name from the dropdown menu.




- In order to share content with participants, select **Share Screen**, and select the appropriate application/screen.




- To designate an alternate host for the hearing, select **More** next to the participant's name, and select **Make Host/Co-Host**. Hosts can control the hearing, mute/unmute individuals, rename individuals and place participants in a Waiting Room.




- In order to admit participants into the hearing, under the **Participants** pane, select the **Waiting Room** dropdown. Select **Admit**. Note: The host may also broadcast a message to the participants in the waiting room. Select **Message** to send a message to everyone in the Waiting Room.




- The host has multiple options to monitor the participants in the hearing. Under the **Participants** screen, select **Mute** to mute the participant's audio. The host may also select **Mute All** to mute the audio for all participants. Under **More**, the host can select **Stop Video** to disable a participant's video.



- In order to invite individuals who may not have the meeting information, select the **Meeting Information** icon, on the upper left corner of the screen. Provide attendees with either the **Meeting ID/Passcode** or **Invite Link**.



12. In order to leave the meeting, select **End**, and select **End Meeting for All** or Leave Meeting. **End Meeting for All** will end the Zoom meeting for all participants.



Important Things to Note:

- Using headphones with a microphone set is highly recommended. This will prevent echoing or background noises that cause distraction within the hearing.
