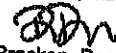

**TITLE: AUTHORIZATION FOR ORANGE COUNTY SOCIAL SERVICES AGENCY
AND ORANGE COUNTY PROBATION TO EXCHANGE INFORMATION
PURSUANT TO WELFARE AND INSTITUTIONS CODE SECTIONS 272,
903.1, 903.2, 903.25 and 903.4.**

**TO: DIRECTOR, ORANGE COUNTY SOCIAL SERVICES AGENCY
CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER, ORANGE COUNTY PROBATION
DEPARTMENT**

In accordance with Welfare and Institutions Code sections 272, 903.1, 903.2, 903.25, and 903 .4, it is necessary from time to time that employees of the Orange County Social Services Agency and Orange County Probation Department exchange information to assign financial liability for incurred costs to the county or court.

FOR GOOD CAUSE SHOWN THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that employees of the Orange County Social Services Agency and Orange County Probation Department are authorized to share information for the purposes of carrying out the responsibilities prescribed in Sections 272, 903 .1, 903.2, 903.25, and 903.4 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, and Resolution No. 74-253 of the Orange County Board of

Supervisors of Orange County, dated February 19, 1974 (also attached as Exhibit A to this Order).

Information contained in Social Services Agency and Probation Department files and records is confidential and shall only be utilized as outlined in this Order.

Notwithstanding Local Rule 900.1.3, this Order will not expire absent further order of the Court.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

February 19, 1974

On motion of Supervisor Baker, duly seconded and carried, the following Resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, this Board by Minute Order dated August 7, 1973, directed the County Administrative Officer, Welfare Director, and County Probation Officer to study the feasibility of transferring the dependent child function from the Probation Department to the Welfare Department; and

WHEREAS, the County Administrative Officer, by letter dated February 8, 1974, has reported to this Board on the above subject;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Administrative Officer's report dated February 8, 1974, is hereby accepted and the concept of transferring the Orange County Probation Department's dependent child care function to the Welfare Department, including intake, investigation, and supervision services is hereby approved on an incremental basis starting July 1, 1974, with a target completion date of June 30, 1975.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Dependent Child Care Study Committee is hereby directed to prepare a detailed implementation plan for the transfer, including organizational and budgetary requirements, and report back to this Board in 60 days.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Position Control List is hereby amended to read as follows:

WELFARE (code 0912)

Add: 1 Social Service Supervisor IV position, class code 7069 at salary range 63, making a total of 3 authorized positions.

Add: 1 Clerk III (Supervisory) position, class code 0508 at salary range 35, making a total of 10 authorized positions.

These positions are to take effect February 19, 1974.
