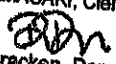

**TITLE: AUTHORIZATION FOR THE EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION
CONCERNING MINORS OF FOREIGN CITIZENSHIP BETWEEN THE
CONSULATE OF THE RESPECTIVE GOVERNMENT AND THE ORANGE
COUNTY PROBATION DEPARTMENT**

**TO: CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER, ORANGE COUNTY PROBATION
DEPARTMENT**

The Orange County Juvenile Court authorizes the release and exchange of information concerning minors of foreign nationality, who are wards of the Juvenile Court pursuant to Section 602 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, are the subject of a petition to declare the minor a ward, or are the subject of an application for such petition, to the Consulate of the appropriate government. The purposes for the exchange of information shall be to:

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1. Investigate and make necessary contracts to determine the minor's true name, date of birth, and legal residence; and/or
2. Contact the minor's parents to inform them of their child's detention, whereabouts, and possible consequences; and/or
3. Assist the Deputy Probation Officers in the preparation of a social study report and provide any criminal record the minor may have in his/her native county; and/or
4. Ascertain the financial status of the minor and family as it applies to the ability to pay restitution and legal expenses incurred in the United States.

Notwithstanding Local Rule 900.1.3, this Order will not expire absent further order of the Court.
