**TITLE: AUTHORIZATION FOR THE ORANGE COUNTY PROBATION
DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE NOTICE TO VICTIMS FOR THE PURPOSE
OF COLLECTING RESTITUTION**

**TO: CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER, ORANGE COUNTY PROBATION
DEPARTMENT**

Pursuant to Sections 730.6 and 730.7 of the Welfare and Institutions Code and
Section 1214 of the Penal Code, the victim(s) is entitled to obtain all information allowed by
law to pursue collection of restitution as if it were a money judgement.

FOR GOOD CAUSE SHOWN THEREFOR, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the
Orange County Probation Department is authorized to obtain from the Juvenile Court, on
behalf of the victim(s) and upon request by the victim(s), a certified copy of the Restitution
Order which includes, but is not limited to:

1. The name and address of the minor ordered to make restitution;
2. The amount and any terms or conditions of restitution;
3. The offense or offenses that were sustained; and;
4. The name and address of the parent or guardian of the minor.

1 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, after probation terminates and an outstanding
2 restitution balance remains, the Orange County Probation Department is authorized, upon
3 request by the victim(s), to provide to the victim(s) the recorded Abstract of Judgment (an
4 instrument which will allow the victim[s] to continue pursuing collection after the minor is no
5 longer on probation) filed with the County Clerk-Recorder's Office for the remaining
6 restitution balance.

7 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, on behalf of the victim(s) and upon request by the
8 victim (s), the Orange County Probation Department is authorized to release all necessary
9 information to the victim(s) to enforce the Restitution Order pursuant to Section 1214 (b) of
10 the Penal Code.

11 Notwithstanding Local Rule 900.1.3, this Order will not expire absent further order of
12 the Court.
