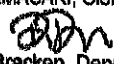

**TITLE: AUTHORIZATION FOR THE RELEASE OF NAMES AND LOCATIONS OF
MINORS SPECIFIED BY ATTORNEYS FROM THE PUBLIC DEFENDER'S
OFFICE AND ADMITTANCE INTO JUVENILE HALL**

**TO: CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER, ORANGE COUNTY PROBATION
DEPARTMENT**

Due to the special needs that arise in the representation of minors, from time to time Attorneys employed by the Orange County Public Defender's Office may seek access to juveniles who are detained in Juvenile Hall (or one of the other institutions maintained by the Probation Department) prior to the minors' first appearances in court or before the Public Defender has been appointed to represent such minors.

FOR GOOD CAUSE SHOWN THEREFOR, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, upon the request of an Attorney employed by the Orange County Public Defender's Office, the

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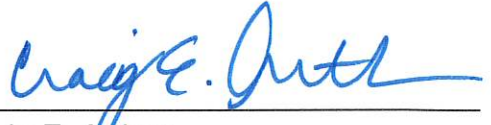
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1 Probation Department shall provide the name and housing location of a minor as described
2 by the Attorney without further order of the Juvenile Court.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Attorneys from the Orange County Public
4 Defender's Office shall be allowed entrance into Juvenile Hall (and other institutions
5 maintained by the Probation Department) to meet with, and interview, such minors in an
6 unmonitored booth without further order of the Juvenile Court.

7 Notwithstanding Local Rule 900.1.3, this Order will not expire absent further order of
8 the Court.
