

Rule 602.01 Notice to Entities

Where notice to an entity is required in any proceeding under the Probate Code, including but not limited to an estate or trust case, notice must be given to either the registered agent for service of process or to a natural person authorized to receive notice on behalf of the entity. The relevant petition, form, supplement, or proof of service must include the entity's name, the name of the agent or other authorized natural person, the person's title, and the person's address. The term "entity" as used in this local rule includes, but is not limited to, any corporation, charity, organization, company, municipality, public agency, private agency, or limited liability company.
