STIPULATION FOR EXPEDITED RULING

Suspending all civil matters due to the COVID-19 pandemic required the Orange County Superior Court to continue *en masse* all motion hearings in all civil departments for approximately three months. (See OC Super. Ct. 4/24/20 2nd Am. Admin. Order 20/06.) The court is prepared to entertain oral argument on the reset hearing date, consistent with the parties' rights. (See *Titmas v. Superior Court* (2001) 87 Cal.App.4th 738, 742-743.)

If the parties would like an earlier ruling, they may stipulate to file the remaining briefing early and submit on the papers without oral argument. In exchange, the court will expedite its ruling by processing the motion as chambers work on evenings and weekends.

Accordingly, the parties stipulate to expedite the resolution of their pending motion(s) by agreeing to this briefing schedule, knowingly and voluntarily waive their rights to oral argument:
