VOLUNTARY SURRENDER ON JUVENILE COURT WARRANT

TO: CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER, COUNTY OF ORANGE

When a subject voluntarily surrenders on a Juvenile Court Warrant at a time when the Juvenile Court is not in session, the subject is booked into Juvenile Hall or Orange County Jail to await arraignment.

FOR GOOD CAUSE SHOWN THEREFOR, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Chief Probation Officer, or designee, is authorized to conditionally release the subject on his/her promise to appear in the following specific instances:

- 1. The Risk Assessment Instrument ("RAI") scores for release or the Home Supervision Program and there are mitigating case factors which would indicate the likelihood the youth would appear for a court hearing the following day;
- 2. The youth has been in the community for an extended period of time since the warrant was issued with no new law violations;

- 3. The youth has been in the community for an extended period of time since the warrant was issued and has aged out of the juvenile justice system; or
- 4. The warrant was issued on a pro per pretrial and there is evidence the youth never received the initial notice to appear in court.
